I. Stadium Village University Station Area Plan

1. Focus on incorporating pedestrian and bike travel through the neighborhood. (Not a lot of bike routes through the area; Minneapolis wants to improve this.) The city wants to incorporate Huron Blvd as part of this plan even though Huron is an interstate exit.
2. Better involvement of neighborhood
3. The University is looking to purchase the remaining 2/3 of the blocks between Essex and Fulton between Oak and Huron. This will not happen for several years.
4. Envision the redevelopment of warehouses in Prospect Park.
5. Discussion of increasing green space and more seating space around the Stadium Village businesses.
6. Possibility of applying for "Entertainment District" status in order to increase signage choices.

II. Current Issues/Miscellaneous

1. Cars are being parked the wrong way on Delaware. This may confuse drivers.
2. Cars parked on Fulton despite "No Parking" signs.
3. Beautify the area around the Huron Blvd to appeal to parents/potential students visiting the University and Vikings fans.
